UAE Federal National Council and the Parliament of the Republic

of Latvia. Emphasizes the following:

- Common interests in enhancement of the security, stability, peace and protection of human rights.
- Common interests in consolidation of bilateral relations between both countries.
- Common interests in the domains of sustainable development, shaping the future and innovation as well as exchange of diplomatic know-how between both parties.
- Exerting common efforts to fight extremisms, terrorism and whatever would be of an impact on the peoples' security, stability and development.
- Counseling and exchanging views on the issues of common concern.
- Respect of international covenants in the first place of which come UN Charter, International Law, International Humanitarian Law and international conventions ratified under national procedures.

Therefore, both Parties have agreed upon the following:

First: Enhancement of the cooperation frameworks and exchange of views on various issues of common concern.

Second: Enhancement of communication through the speaker of the Parliament of the Republic of Latvia and UAE Federal National speaker by:

- Exchange of visits and parliamentary activities between both parties.
- Arrangement of official visits for meeting governmental officials of both parties.

Third: This Agreement shall enter into force subsequent to being signed by the Parliament of the Republic of Latvia speaker and UAE Federal National Council speaker.

Fourth: Either party may terminate/amend this agreement subsequent to the consent of the other party provided that a memorandum would be served in this respect at least three months prior to termination/amendment.
